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Gair gan y Pennaeth / Word from the Headteacher

Croeso i Gylchlythyr cyntaf y flwyddyn academiaidd hon. Mae'n flwyddyn arbennig eleni gan fod Ysgol y Preseli yn dathlu ei phen-blwydd yn 60oed. Braf oedd cael croesawu nifer o ddisgyblion cyntaf yr ysgol nôl i'r Preseli ar fore Sadwrn, Medi 8fed. Sefydlwyd yr ysgol yn 1958 gyda'r ysgol yn newid i fod yn ysgol ddwyieithog yn 1991. Ers y dyddiau cynnar hynny gyda 65 o ddisgyblion mae'r ysgol wedi mynd o nerth i nerth. Rydym yn ymfalchïo'n fawr yn y rôl mae Ysgol y Preseli wedi chwarae yn nhwf addysg Gymraeg yn Sir Benfro. Yn sgil llwyddiant ein hysgol agorwyd Ysgol Hafan y Môr yn Ninbych y Pysgod yn 2017 ac Ysgol Caer Elen, Hwlfordd yn 2018.

Bu'r 60 mlynedd diwethaf yn llewyrchus iawn i Ysgol y Preseli ac wrth iddi ddechrau cynllunio ar gyfer cyfnod newydd yn ei hanes, mae angen sicrhau bod ganddi ddyfodol llwyddiannus o'i blaen.

Welcome to the first edition of the school newsletter Y Garreg Las of this academic year. It is a very special year for Ysgol y Preseli as it celebrates its 60th birthday. It was a pleasure to welcome back to school on Saturday, September 8th a number of the very first pupils to have attended Ysgol y Preseli. The school was opened in 1958 and it became an official bilingual school in 1991. Since its early days with 65 pupils the school has gone from strength to strength. We are very proud of the role the school has played in the success of Welsh Medium Education and the increasing demand has led to the opening of Ysgol Hafan y Môr in Tenby in 2017 and Ysgol Caer Elen Haverfordwest in 2018.

The past 60 years have been very prosperous for Ysgol y Preseli and as we prepare to plan for a new period in its history we need to guarantee that the school has a successful future.

Congratulations to those students who sat their A Levels and GCSE's on their excellent results. Ysgol y Preseli is the only secondary school in Pembrokeshire to have been benchmarked in the top quartile for all the key performance measures at key stage 4. We will continue to strive to build on our achievements and improve on our performance.

Now onto the next half term as we look forward to hearing about more achievements and successes within the year group.



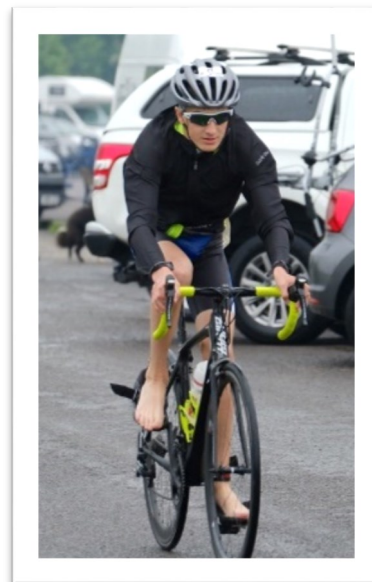
Blwyddyn 11 / Year 11

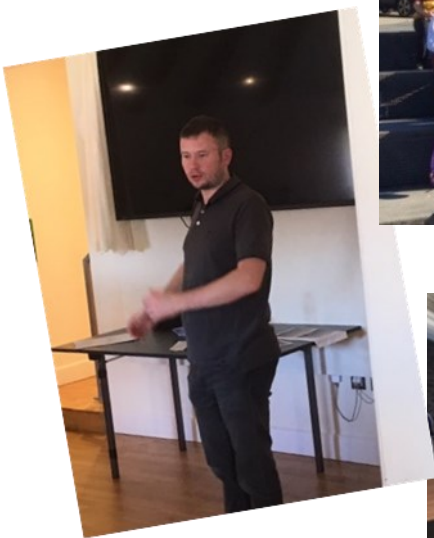

Shakespeare Schools Festival

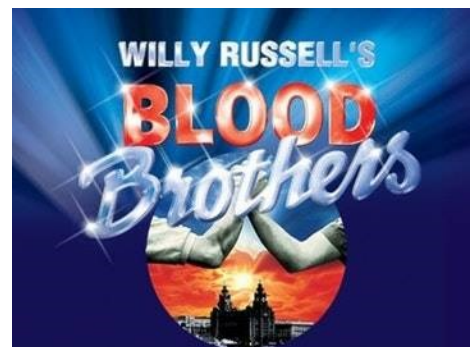

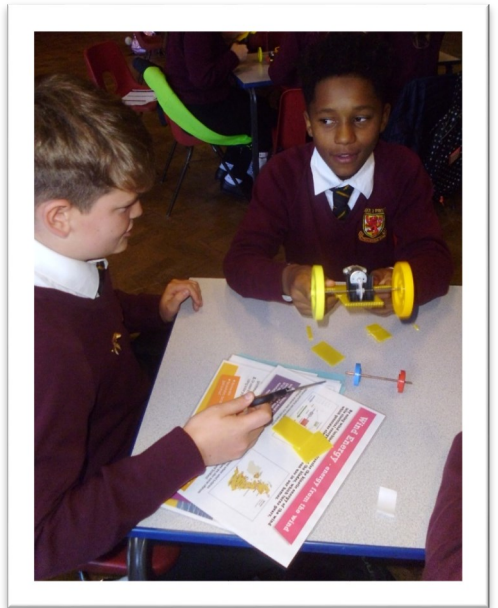

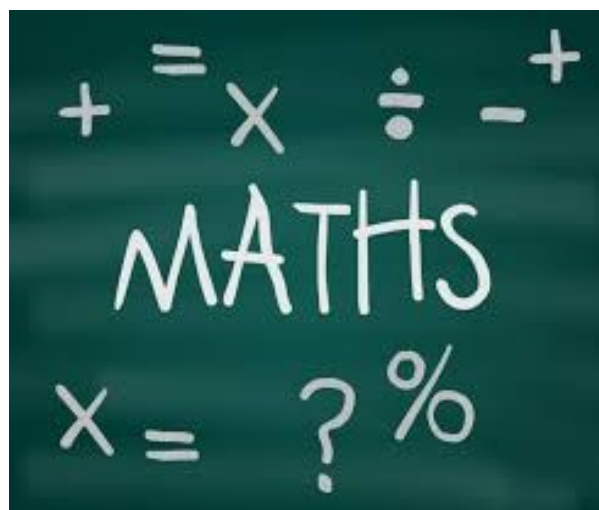
Mathemateg / Mathematics

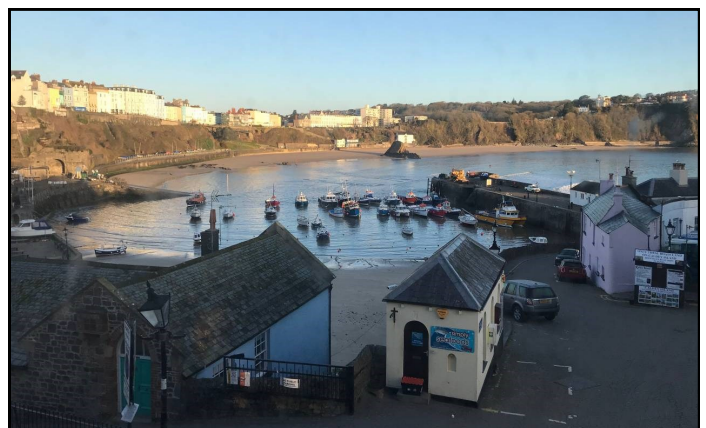

As a part of the GCSE Geography course, we undertook two days of fieldwork in order to collect data. On the first day, we visited the town of Llanelli. The pupils' task was to study how Trostre Retail Park had affected the town centre since its opening in 2008. The pupils conducted land use surveys, environment quality assessments and completed questionnaires. It was obvious from visiting Llanelli that the town can be considered a clone town as it is dominated by chain or empty stores, suffering decline since the opening of Trostre.

The following day, our focus was to look at how Tenby is being affected by mass tourism. The pupils looked at how the town's amenities and shops were tailored towards visitors and if we can consider Tenby a honey-pot site. The two days were interesting and enjoyable and certainly helped the pupils with their understanding of the Geography course. This will be invaluable for their coursework.

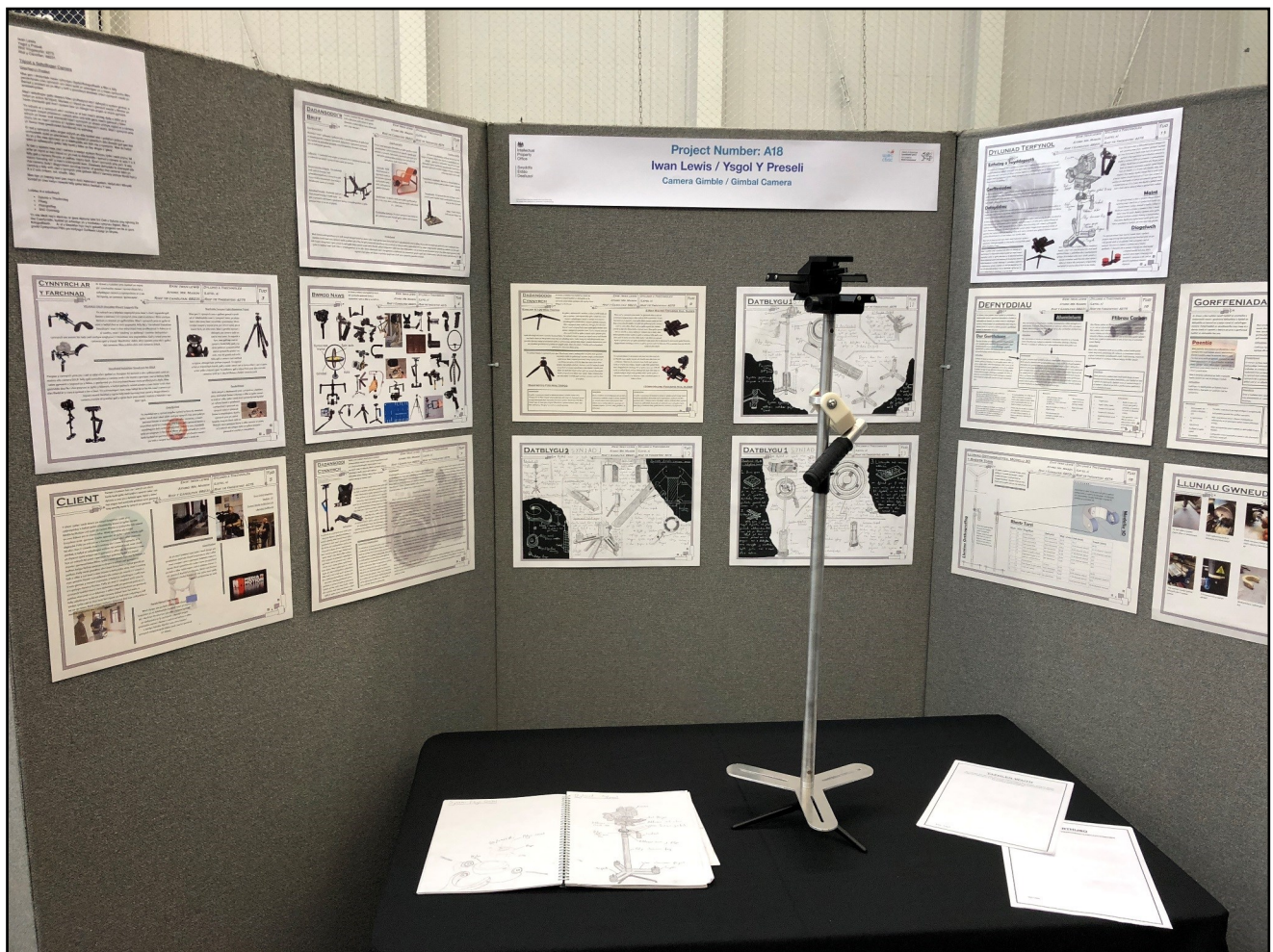

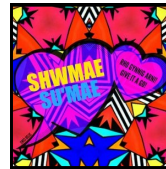
