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Gair Gan y Pennaeth / Word From the Headteacher

Braint ac anrhydedd oedd derbyn gwahoddiad y Corff Llywodraethol Dros Dro ac Awdurdod Addysg Sir Benfro i arwain Ysgol Gymraeg Newydd 3-16 Hwlfordd ac Ysgol y Preseli fel Pennaeth Gweithredol.

Rwy'n edrych ymlaen yn fawr at y sialens o sefydlu a datblygu'r ysgol newydd ochr yn ochr â sicrhau bod safonau Ysgol y Preseli yn parhau ymysg y gorau yn y wlad. Hoffwn longyfarch Mr Trystan Phillips, Mrs Meleri Williams y tîm o athrawon teithiol a disgyblion yr ysgol am eu llwyddiant eleni yng Ngwyl Valero. Llwyddodd yr ysgol i ennill 38 o wobrau amrywiol. Llongyfarchiadau i chi gyd.

Rwy'n falch iawn bod disgyblion Ysgol y Preseli yn gyson yn meddwl am eraill ac yn gwneud cyfraniadau ariannol i blant dan anfantais. Codwyd dros £8,000 tuag at elusen Plant Mewn Angen eleni. Our aim will be to develop a pioneering 3-16 school which will deliver Welsh-medium education of the highest quality in partnership with Ysgol y Preseli and the feeder primary schools.

I would like to congratulate Mr Trystan Phillips, Mrs Meleri Williams the team of peripatetic music leaders and the pupils on their successes in this year's Valero Music Festival. The School was awarded 38 separate prizes. Congratulations to everyone.

I am very proud that pupils at Ysgol y Preseli are always thinking of others and of children less fortunate than themselves. Over £8,000 was raised for Children In Need on November 16th. Congratulations to the Year 10 Welsh Baccalaureate pupils for organising the activities and to the teachers for supporting them.

Thank you very much to everyone who attended our annual Christmas Fayre which was held at the school on Thursday, November 30th. Almost £5,000 was raised towards school funds. This is an excellent sum and special thanks to the members of the Friends of Ysgol y Preseli committee and the office staff for coordinating the activities.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for their cooperation and support during 2017 and on behalf of the staff and governors of Ysgol y Preseli, I wish you all a very Happy Christmas and prosperous New Year.

Another successful PSE day was held at the end of the term for all year 8 pupils. External providers shared their expertise with pupils on a variety of personal and social issues.



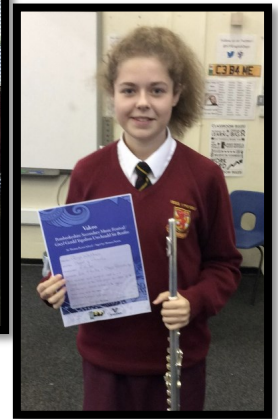
Blwyddyn 9

Boxing is by no means an easy choice. The boys travel the length of the country and follow a brutal training regime. This is all balanced, of course, by GCSE work as both boys are aiming high.

The hope has to be Los Angeles 2022 where I hope to have ring side seats to watch a Preseli triumph!

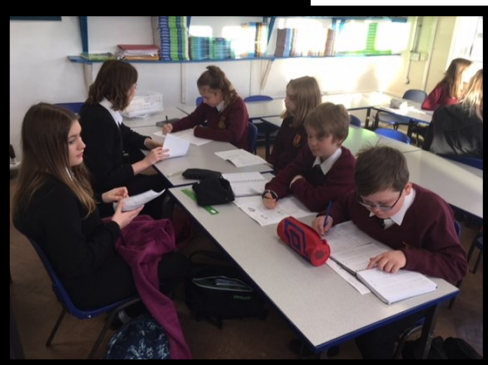

Practical Exams

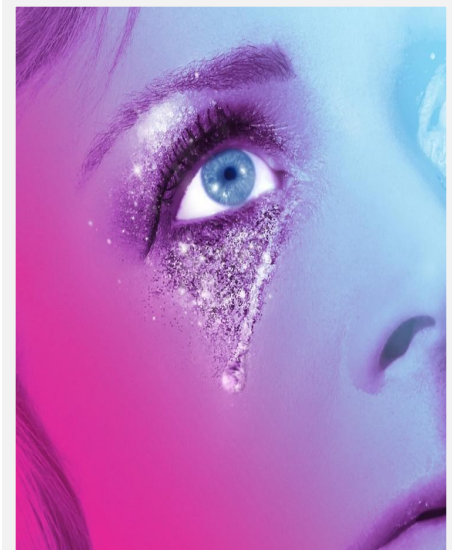

Penalty Notices.

This letter alerts you to the introduction of Penalty notices for unauthorised absences from school from January 2015.

The ERW consortium believe that any absence from school, for whatever reason, is detrimental to a child's long term life opportunities, so should be avoided if at all possible. Reducing absence from school is a key priority, both nationally and locally, because missing school damages a pupil's attainment levels, disrupts school routines and can leave a pupil vulnerable to anti-social behaviour and youth crime.

A Penalty Notice is an alternative to prosecution with the aim of seeking to secure an improvement in the pupil's attendance.

A Penalty Notice can be requested by the School, Police or from within the Local Authority Education Welfare Service in relation to unauthorised non-attendance at school. If a reason for absence is provided by the parent/carer then it is up to the head-teacher to decide if they accept it and mark it appropriately. There is no limit to the number of formal warnings which can be issued

If a notice has been requested the parent/carer will receive a warning letter that gives them 15 days to provide evidence to the Local Authority that the unauthorised absences are justified and that the register should be amended. If the unauthorised absences are due to taking a holiday in school time then a warning will not be issued.

If the school attendance does not improve then the **penalty notice will be issued. Payment of £60 will be due** in the first instance which may rise to £120 if not paid promptly. If the penalty is not paid then the Local Authority (LA) will consider **issuing prosecution proceedings against parent(s)** for the original offence, which is 'failure to ensure regular attendance at school of the registered pupil' under **Section 444 (1) or (1A)** of the Education Act 1996.

Please remember that if there are reasons why your child is missing school then you can seek support and guidance from staff at your child's school. Ask before the non-attendance becomes an issue.
